Agreement in purpose and practice

Matthew 18:19, *Again I say to you that if two of you agree on earth concerning anything that they ask, it will be done for them by My Father in heaven.*

1 Corinthians 1:10, *Now I plead with you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that you all speak the same thing, and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment.*

Philippians 2:2, *Fulfill my joy by being like-minded, having the same love, being of one accord, of one mind.*

Philippians 3:16, *Nevertheless, to the degree that we have already attained, let us walk by the same rule, let us be of the same mind.*

Grace to assemble and gather on time

Hebrews 10:24-25 *And let us consider one another in order to stir up love and good works, 25 not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as is the manner of some, but exhorting one another, and so much the more as you see the Day approaching.*

Romans 12:11, *Not lagging in diligence, fervent in spirit, serving the Lord;*

Grace to be doers of the word

Romans 10:16 *But they have not all obeyed the gospel. For Isaiah says, "Lord, who has believed our report?" 17 So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.*

Corinthians 4:6 *Now these things, brethren, I have figuratively transferred to myself and Apollos for your sakes, that you may learn in us not to think beyond what is written, that none of you may be puffed up on behalf of one against the other..*

1 Peter 2:1-3, *Therefore, laying aside all malice, all deceit, hypocrisy, envy, and all evil speaking, 2 as newborn babes, desire the pure milk of the word, that you may grow [a]thereby, 3 if indeed you have tasted that the Lord is gracious*

James 1:22, *But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves."*

Grace to Give and Receive

2 Corinthians 9:8 *And God is able to make all grace abound toward you, that you, always having all sufficiency in all things, may have an abundance for every good work.*

Luke 6:38, *Give, and it will be given to you: good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over will be put into your bosom. For with the same measure that you use, it will be measured back to you."*

2 Corinthians 8:7 *But as you abound in everything—in faith, in speech, in knowledge, in all diligence, and in your love for us—see that you abound in this grace [giving] also.*

Grace for Progress in Employment

Joshua 1:8, *This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate in it day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success.*

Psalms 90:17 *And let the beauty of the Lord our God be upon us, And establish the work of our hands for us; Yes, establish the work of our hands.*

Proverbs 12:24, *The hand of the diligent will rule, But the lazy man will be put to forced labor.*

Colossians 3:23, *And whatever you do, do it heartily, as to the Lord and not to men.*

1 Thessalonians 4:11, *that you also aspire to lead a quiet life, to mind your own business, and to work with your own hands, as we commanded you, 12 that you may walk properly toward those who are outside, and that you may lack nothing*

Grace for Retirees

Psalms 92:12, *The righteous shall flourish like a palm tree, He shall grow like a cedar in Lebanon. Those who are planted in the house of the Lord Shall flourish in the courts of our God. They shall still bear fruit in old age; They shall be fresh and flourishing,*

Proverbs 16:31 *The silver-haired head is a crown of glory, If it is found in the way of righteousness.*

Grace for Youth Justice Outreach

Isaiah 1:17, *Learn to do good; Seek justice, Rebuke the oppressor; Defend the fatherless, Plead for the widow.*

Micah 6:8 *He has shown you, O man, what is good; And what does the Lord require of you But to do justly, To love mercy, And to walk humbly with your God?*

Proverbs 31:8–9, *Open your mouth for the speechless, In the cause of all who are appointed to die. Open your mouth, judge righteously, And plead the cause of the poor and needy.*

Grace for Wheeler Mission and People in Need

Matthew 25:40, *And the King will answer and say to them, 'Assuredly, I say to you, inasmuch as you did it to one of the least of these My brethren, you did it to Me.'*

Matthew 25:35, *For I was hungry and you gave Me food; I was thirsty and you gave Me drink; I was a stranger and you took Me in.*

Proverbs 19:17, *He who has pity on the poor lends to the Lord, And He will pay back what he has given.*

Hebrews 13:16, *But do not forget to do good and to share, for with such sacrifices God is well pleased.*

Grace for Seniors Needing Care

Isaiah 40:29, *He gives power to the weak, And to those who have no might He increases strength.*

Psalms 55:22 *Cast your burden on the Lord, And He shall sustain you; He shall never permit the righteous to be moved.*

Grace for Caregivers

Galatians 6:9, *And let us not grow weary while doing good, for in due season we shall reap if we do not lose heart.*

Psalms 121:1-2, *I lift my eyes to the hills — where does my help come from? My help comes from the Lord, the maker of heaven and earth.*

Jeremiah 29:11, *"For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not harm you, plans to give you hope and a future."*

Isaiah 41:10, (NAB) *Do not fear: I am with you; do not be anxious: I am your God. I will strengthen you, I will help you, I will uphold you with my victorious right hand.*

Grace for NCC Helps Ministries

Romans 12:3 *For I say, through the grace given to me, to everyone who is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think, but to think soberly, as God has dealt to each one a measure of faith. 4] For as we have many members in one body, but all the members do not have the same function, 5] so we, being many, are one body in Christ, and individually members of one another. 6] Having then gifts differing according to the grace that is given to us, let us use them...*

1 Corinthians 15:10, *But by the grace of God I am what I am, and His grace toward me was not in vain; but I labored more abundantly than they all, yet not I, but the grace of God which was with me.*

Hebrews 6:10 *For God is not unjust to forget your work and labor of love which you have shown toward His name, in that you have ministered to the saints, and do minister.*

Grace for NCC Ministers

Exodus 17:12, *But Moses' hands became heavy; so they took a stone and put it under him, and he sat on it. And Aaron and Hur supported his hands, one on one side, and the other on the other side; and his hands were steady until the going down of the sun.*

Ephesians 4:11, *And He Himself gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers, 12 for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry, for the [a]edifying of the body of Christ, 13 till we all come to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a perfect man, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ*

Philippians 1:6 *Being confident of this very thing, that He who has begun a good work in you will complete it until the day of Jesus Christ.*

2 Timothy 2:15, *Be diligent to present yourself approved to God, a worker who does not need to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth*

2 Timothy 4:1, *I charge you therefore before God and the Lord Jesus Christ, who will judge the living and the dead at His appearing and His kingdom: 2 Preach the word! Be ready in season and out of season. Convince, rebuke, exhort, with all longsuffering and teaching. 3 For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine, but according to their own desires, because they have itching ears, they will heap up for themselves teachers;*

1 Peter 5:3, *Don't lord it over the people assigned to your care, but lead them by your own good example.*

Grace for Capitol Projects

1 Chronicles 29:1, *Furthermore King David said to all the assembly: "My son Solomon, whom alone God has chosen, is young and inexperienced; and the work is great, because **the temple is not for man but for the Lord God.** 2 Now for the house of my God I have prepared with all my might: gold for things to be made of gold, silver for things of silver, bronze for things of bronze, iron for things of iron, wood for things of wood,*

Grace for Health & Wellness

1 Corinthians 6:19 *Or do you not know that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and you are not your own? 20 For you were bought at a price; therefore glorify God in your body and in your spirit, which are God's.*

3 John 1:2 *Beloved, I pray that you may prosper in all things and be in health, just as your soul prospers.*

Isaiah 53:5 *But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace was upon Him, And by His stripes we are healed.*

Grace for Ministry to Children and Youth

Proverbs 22:6 *Train up a child in the way he should go, And when he is old he will not depart from it.*

Mark 10:14 *But when Jesus saw it, He was greatly displeased and said to them, "Let the little children come to Me, and do not forbid them; for of such is the kingdom of God."*
